

Today's market had some promising gains but it wasn't all smooth sailing. The finer edge of the mid-micron wools showed a healthy increase especially in the 22.5-23 micron range ~ lifting by 30 cent but the 24-26.5 micron wools eased back 20 cents on our last South sale. XBD's wool types had a mixed day with BB full length 4-6" wools managing to break the 400c mark. 2/S flc was down 5 cents from our last sale with exporters still spoilt for choice with plenty of selection of very bright white wool on offer. Oddments are still attracting top dollar. Exporters have indicated that they're finding it tough to navigate the new tariff landscape.

Next Sale is a North and South Island on the 28th August 2025 with 16,000 bales rostered.
