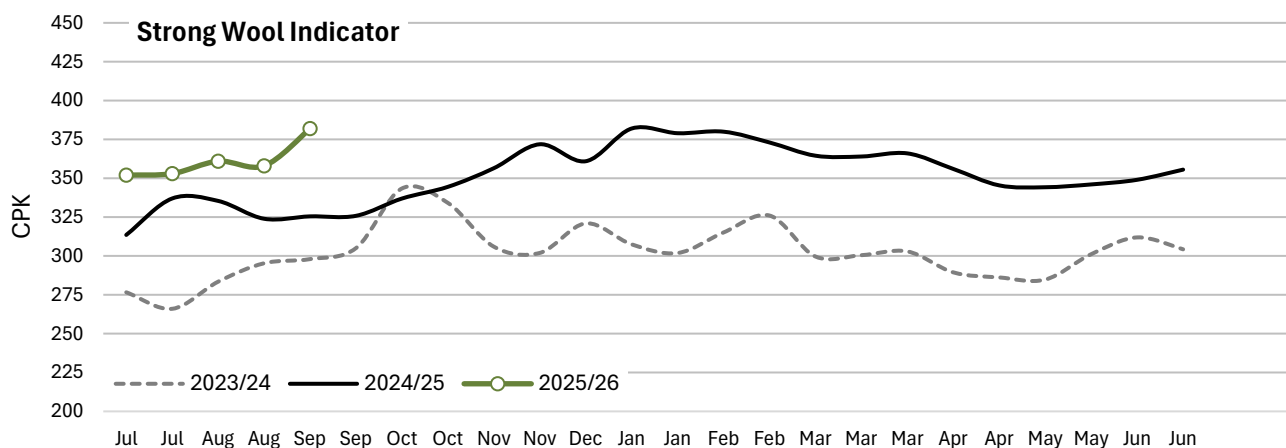

With a small offering of 6,500 bales the market has taken a good lift across the board today ~ To break it down Xbds have lifted 2 to 4 % with the SWI lifting 14c/pkg ~ Strong inquiry out of China has started to push prices along and we are now seeing a price difference for the 34 micron and finer types that we haven't seen for several years. With a large selection of good styled mid micron wools in the sale ~ prices lifted again ~ in the region of 4 to 9%.

The Merinos on offer today have continued to follow the upward trend in Australian market with good increase for the better styled wools.
