

Christchurch has held the first National wool sale to be trialled this season ~ The offering consisted 3,830 bales from the North and 5,594 bales in the South ~ The split being nearly 50/50 fine wool and strong wool.

The strong wool market continued to show some resilience and good coloured shears and fleece remained firm to sellers favour, the finer edge of the hoggets has lost some ground today but still selling at a good level.

Merinos and mid micron wools have taken a tumble, following the price falls in Australia over the last two weeks ~ disappointing after reaching levels not seen for a number of years.

Passings today were 12%. Next sale is a National sale again in Christchurch on the 12th November.
