

Christchurch hosted the second national wool sale this week, delivering generally positive results ~ particularly in the mid-micron range. Fine wools rebounded strongly after the recent dip seen two weeks ago in the Australian market, with 18 micron types lifting by more than one dollar. Mid-micron wools remain at historically high levels not seen for a long time.

XBD and hogget wools encountered some headwinds ~ with finer, longer types easing back slightly from their recent peaks. Good colour 2/S wools held firm, showing continued demand.

Passings were very low ~ reflecting solid buyer confidence.

The next national sale will again be held in Christchurch on November 27th.
